

# Who we are and what we do...

**LLUEST is Welsh for *Safe Haven* and that's just what we do; we have provided a safe haven for neglected, abandoned and often cruelly treated horses and ponies for the last thirty years.**

Lluest was founded by Ginny Hajdukiewicz in 1985 and quickly moved to its current home in the Brecon Beacons. Since then 333 animals have been rescued, rehabilitated and often re-homed. Lluest is a registered charity, which relies completely on charitable giving and fundraising activities for its day to day existence.

Beili Bedw Farm can currently house 30 horses. 122 equines are fostered in loan homes and even more are helped through an outreach programme.

**We depend completely on the generosity and support of kind people like you** and every single penny of your membership or donation will be used directly to support the animals in our care. The horses and ponies that are taken into Lluest have usually been found abandoned and so have no personal history. Consequently, they all need quarantining to prevent the possible spread of infectious diseases to the rest of the herd. **It costs £500 for six weeks of isolation** and all will have their blood screened to help assess their general health, worm treatment, gelding (if necessary), vaccinations, microchipping, passporting and of course feeding.

**WHAT YOU GET:** You will receive two newsletters a year, as emails or by post, updating you on the work at Lluest and enabling you to find out more about the individual stories behind our horses and ponies.

**Donations** The most useful donation is a regular donation, which we can use to ensure that our monthly bills are met.

**MONTHLY:** For the cost of a sandwich and a coffee or a cream tea, say **£4-6 each month**, we can buy a bale of hay or a sack of carrots.

**£10-15 a month**, the cost of a pub lunch, would pay for a farrier visit to trim a horse's hooves, giving much needed relief from lameness caused by long term neglect or one essential Tetanus vaccination for a vulnerable pony or buy a bag of horse food and a bale of hay.

**£20-£25 a month** cares for approximately three horses for one day or a months supply of warm, soft bedding for a recovering pony.

**£30 a month** would pay for one dental check-up ensuring our horses and ponies are pain free, healthy and happy.
